With the outstanding ability of the volunteers and their expertise counselling methodology has always been appreciated by the children and the orphanage management. CHF's active involvement in the counselling activity has become a pioneer in providing welfare for the orphan children of Nepal.

This program has several wonderful outcomes. The most significant outcome is that children get the opportunity for exposure. Volunteer team's familiarity with the children has been very helpful to address every child's psychological issues and in every case. Majority of the children seem to become participative and speak up their mind among our team. Every month, more than a hundred children are addressed by our team. This program has become a platform to maintain a good mental health for the deprived children.

As far as possible, the team has been using sophisticated tools for presenting varieties of things for the children. The orphanages who possess projectors and laptops will be used with slides so that it becomes more attractive for the children and efficient for everyone. Generally, the children will be classified into groups (referring to their age) and open discussion sessions will be held. And finally, the children will be sitting together making a presentation of their skills such as their drawings, songs and compositions, special abilities as well as express their feelings in front of everybody present in the room.
